Give thanks ...

1. That, despite a very difficult month both operationally and financially, AN was eventually able to meet all its obligations for January.
2. The distribution of aid worth over £55,000 during 2012.
3. For another load from Billingshurst this week - an encouragement to continue.

Please pray ...

1. For **Maria Coropca** and her family. Last weekend their house burnt down after an accident with the stove. The children were rescued by neighbours but the eldest sustained 40% burns and was airlifted to the national burns hospital where he has had to have several skin-grafts. (Their father had drowned in October 2011.)
2. For **Fani**. She is one of the last of the Jewish remnant in Dorohoi. Shortly after New Year she fell and rolled under her bed, tipping the radiator against the door. She was found after several days, but is still shocked by the experience.
3. For **Iulian**. He has worked with AN almost since the charity was founded, and his is a most friendly, cheerful and obliging colleague. Now he needs a gall bladder removal at a cost of £350 (2½ months' wages) but the hospital will not treat him due to high blood pressure. This requires additional treatment. Please pray that God will give him peace of mind, together with physical and spiritual healing.

Below and overleaf we offer some prayer pointers, but please feel free to add your own items as they come to mind. Prayer is our connection with God's ultimate power source and, without prayer support, this work would achieve nothing.

Give thanks ...

1. For sufficient goods and funds to send another lorry to Dorohoi last weekend. Thanks especially to all those involved with preparing the items and those who turned out to help load the lorry.
2. The continuing provision of funds which confirms that we are still following God's will in maintaining this work.
3. For the increasing level of family-to-family interest and sponsorship. Some 20 families receive financial sponsorship each month and about 25 households get designated boxes which have been sent on the lorries.

Please pray ...

1. For an increase in local interest, particularly in Billingshurst and Swansea, so that the work in the warehouses can be shared more equitably. We also need to emulate the success of Horley's Friday packing team, which acts as an outreach to those who bring items and those non-Church people who join in with the packing.
2. For the preparations for the next lorries, firstly from west and south Wales in late March, and then from Billingshurst, hopefully in mid-May.
3. For those associated with RoAF who are suffering ill-health. Some have various cancers and others have other illnesses. We know that God likes to use weak and apparently insignificant people, but we need to wait upon him to renew our strength. (Plus a bit of fresh blood would energise us all!)
4. That the anti-Romanian stance of sections of the UK press will not discourage people from helping to sustain needy Romanians in their own country.
