During November, AN donated goods to a total value of approximately $\pounds7,000$ to some 270 beneficiaries. In addition, cash donations were given to help people pay for medical expenses, fuel bills and essential house repairs in preparation for the winter. These activities are supported by the income from the shop in Dorohoi.

In December, AN has the opportunity to get involved with the local community through the distribution of Christmas gift boxes in schools and churches.

1. For the pre-Christmas load that arrived last week, including some 2,000 Christmas gift boxes and two tons of food.

2. For the good stock of clothing, bedding and food that will be used to help many people during the coming winter.

3. For the dedicated local team which gets involved in all aspects of AN's work.

1. About proposed legislation in Romania that would make it more difficult for some foreign-funded charities to continue their activities.

2. For the increasing number of people asking for help - 14 first-time beneficiaries were registered during the last week of November alone.
