The trailer shown below was already old when given to us but it is still in regular use some 20 years later. A kindergarten climbing frame is now used by the children of its original recipients. We are looking forward to the pleasure of distributing a fresh consignment of kindergarten equipment, with the anticipation that it too will bring pleasure for many years. September brings the start of the new school year. Parents face additional costs, for school uniforms, books and stationery. Fortunately, we are well stocked with these particular items and will be to help those families that cannot afford them.

1. For progress with the provision of a home for the ex-orphanage boys. The land purchase is complete and plans are being prepared for building next spring.
2. For a large consignment of tables and chairs. These have proven very popular amongst those households who have little in the way of furniture.

Please pray ...

1. For guidance with the detailed design of the boys' accommodation.
2. For guidance when balancing competing priorities, especially when dealing with those who are asking for more than their fair share.

A new localised leaflet, with instructions for preparing the boxes, and has been distributed to schools and churches in the Swansea area. Some boxes have already arrived in Dorohoi ready for Christmas. The boxes are still the highlight of the season for many families. The transport deadline for boxes from south and west Wales is at the end of October but boxes that are ready in time will go in mid-September.

1. For additional funding towards the provision of a house where the ex-orphanage boys can find a more settled home.
2. For a large donation of nursery equipment for use in kindergartens in the villages around Dorohoi, plus the funds to get it there.
3. For several 'coincidences' that indicate God's will for this work to continue.

Please pray ...

1. For the shoebox appeal, especially that there will be enough boxes to avoid disappointment amongst those who may receive very little else.
2. For protection and 'God speed' as the donated items are transported to Romania
3. For an increase in the committed regular income, so that future activities can be planned with confidence.
4. For additional, preferably younger, people to recognise the vision of our work and become actively involved on a regular basis.
