The nursery equipment was about a third of a lorry. We put it separately upstairs in the warehouse and will donate it to Kindergartens in the area.

Last week we donated 6 mattresses and 7 baby bags. On Friday we took the sunflower (620 Kg) to the mill and have made about 200 litres of oil.

Richard brought the money for the new van. We have registered it with the same number and I'm very pleased with it. Thank you to all who made this possible.
