Easter still retains a religious significance for the majority of the population, even if they are not regular church-goers, combining thoughts of resurrection and new life with the practicalities of Spring and new growth. However, the change of season brings expectations - some extra food, maybe new clothes - that many people find difficult to resolve. The resources stocked up for winter have been exhausted but their replacements are a long way off. There are many calls for help at this time, particularly with bills that have accrued during the winter, but not all these requests can be satisfied.
