Work has started on building the home for the ex-orphanage boys. The building team has enjoyed dry weather and the walls have reached full height for the first storey. Now preparations are under way for the pouring of the upper floor slab.

Conversely, the dry weather has been less helpful for those raising crops as the lack of rain means that many hours have to be spent tending to the plants.

As last year, we have received sponsorship specifically to allow some 30 children to attend a Christian camp in the mountains at the end of this month. The children are being chosen from our beneficiary families and are those who are unlikely to have any other opportunity for a holiday away from home.
