The windows and external doors have been installed at the Boys' new house, making the structure weather-tight for the coming winter. This will probably be the last major step this year, although the electrical installation can continue. The last of the vegetables are being harvested and will be donated to needy families.

1. For 200 litres of sunflower oil from our crop at the warehouse - more than expected - for donation to needy families.
2. For being able to weather-proof the new building before the onset of winter.
3. For a joint venture with the Centre of Hope whereby we can give donations of firewood to help people stay warm this winter.

1. For several members of the AN team who are suffering from ailments resulting from the abrupt change in the season.
2. That newly planted cereal crops for next year will get a good start during the autumn and that there will not be a repeat of this year's poor harvest.

The packing area at the new HBC is spacious and inviting, and we have plenty of room for more helpers.

From Swansea, the team reports that this is a busy time for giving talks to groups interested in preparing shoeboxes; some 460 boxes are ready and a further 500 expected. There has been good progress too with fund raising through car-boot sales and recycling; with funding for next year's children's camp ahead of target.

2. For a generous donation that will allow RoAF to plan for another lorry from Billingshurst early in the new year.
