So the vote has been cast, the outcome is known but the longer-term effects have yet to become apparent. The allures of established free trade will carry a great deal of weight in the decisions that will be made in due course, and certainly our first lorry 'post-vote' met no major hurdles at the border crossings. However, the needy in Romania do not have the chance to opt out of their situation. The benefits of EU membership have been enjoyed by the political classes and business leaders but at the expense of higher prices and a lower quality of life for those who are less privileged. For those with the initiative and resources there is the opportunity to head west in search of a better future but for the remainder there is little hope for improvements in the short term.
