June 2017

Spring is an erratic season in this area of Romania – the first hints arrived in February, with a temperature variation of 36C two weeks apart only to be followed by a return to winter in March. In early May, spring appeared again, followed a month later by what appears to be the start of summer. For those able to make the necessary preparations, Spring has brought the promise of agricultural employment, good crops and an abundance of animal fodder - one local farmer has reported cutting 61 bales of hay from a field that yielded only 3 bales last year. Once again, AN was able to supply some seeds and help to those wanting to grow their own crops.

However, there are still those who, for a variety of reasons, cannot take advantage of the season. These include the elderly, the sick and those who have no access to land or other employment. During May, AN distributed over 2.2 tons of oil and rice to needy households.

The annual children's camp at Voronet will take place in the final week of June. As with previous years, the prospect of a few days in the mountains has excited much interest amongst our beneficiary families and we have easily filled our allocated number of places. The camp offers physical recreation coupled with a simple explanation of the Christian faith. This latter dimension is entirely voluntary but several previous campers have commented on how much they appreciated the camp atmosphere.

Elsewhere, spiritual growth is less easy to discern. Our associate, Robert, continues to build relationships with the potential residents of Casa Neemia, the new house for 'ex orphanage' young men, but their difficult backgrounds makes this a slow process.
