Prayer Notes April 2025

We have finally been able to instal the second set of solar panels at Casa Neemia. These panels were donated to us but poor weather and a shortage of contractors delayed their installation. The panels will help to reduce the costs of providing accommodation at Casa Neemia and we hope that they will generate sufficient power to give a surplus which can be sold back into the grid.

Casa Neemia is now home to 15 people, both Romanians and Ukrainians. The latter are families from the area now dominated by Russia and include one disabled person who needs ongoing medical treatment. There is good co-operation between the two groups.

Our dedicated staff and volunteers have been able to help many people during the past few months. This help can be in the form of clothing and household items, sponsored payments for firewood or as part of the food distribution. In addition, we have been offered the opportunity to hold a pre-Easter appeal at two branches of a local supermarket chain.
